They both agreed that even the current teaching situation in Sanmenxia Polytechnic is comparatively well, but music education major needs a broad and rich practice link to promote students' all-round development and improve their innovative ability, but in reality, practice link is usually insufficient, it is difficult to meet students' professional needs and practical ability training. Singing Technique

The history of singing art in China originated from Kunqu Opera and traditional music Art and folk art, etc. Some of Chinese Contemporary national vocal music art singing Skills, such as “enunciation, embellishment, performance” are borrowed from Kunqu Opera, traditional folk art, regional folk song methods and skills, more prominent as a variety of national characteristics. since the reform and opening up, the types and forms of singing have become more and more diverse, and singing skills have gradually become systematic, standardized and scientific. As a kind of sound art, singing expresses different creative ideas, regional styles and various emotions through sound color, rhythm characteristics, speed and vocal range, and shpes. Regarding the relationship between singing skills and vocal music art, Shi Weizheng (2015) believes that the art of singing is a whole and a kind of art. Singing skill is an essential tool in the process of transforming a song from a work to an art. he first proposed the “six states theory”, which summarizes and expound six skills which are helpful to present more perfect performance effect, namely body form, laryngeal form, oral form, glottic state and state of absorption and state of mind. From a technical point of view, a singing performance artist with rich performance experience must have mastered these six skills.

With the development of society, vocal art forms have become diversified, and the importance of singing skills in vocal art performance has gradually become prominent. Only by correctly mastering the skills of singing performance can we better deduce perfect vocal music works. In singing performance, the mastery of singing skills is the key to the success of vocal music performance. Skillful use of singing skills can reduce the error rate of singing, improve the quality of singing, and enhance the beauty of vocal music. By using their own proficiency in singing skills, singers perform vocal works with mixed emotions, not only showing the tone fluctuations in vocal works, but also transmitting the emotional thoughts in the works to the listener, so that the singer and the listener can achieve emotional communication and resonance through the song.

musical elements, such as pitch, time value, beat and so on. Pitch, intonation is the most basic requirements, the sound is not allowed music, how to beauty. The second is the time value of the beat, although a note in singing a little longer and a little shorter does not seem to have much impact on the music, but the rules are the rules, accurate grasp of musical elements is the most basic musical literacy, but also an important performance of rigorous art and excellence.

The pattern of enunciation in singing is also very important for the expression of a piece. The biggest difference between foreign language songs and Chinese songs sung by teaching middle schools is the difference in enunciation, Chinese songs pay attention to "enunciation to rhyme", Chinese is our mother tongue, it pays the most attention to the pronunciation, the beginning of each word to be clear, the end of the word to return to good rhyme. Whether it is a foreign language or a Chinese work, we read the lyrics through before singing, as a poem recitation, pronunciation, emotion, and then sing the work according to its rhyme.

The soul of music is emotion, and human beings have a certain expression of emotion.

As a rule, the singer must reveal his true feelings during the performance in order to move the heart. For example, if you want to express calm, you will not use more color feelings, but use some colors with slow rhythm and dim vocal range. Research Objectives

Research Methodology

The research methodology was qualitative research. The interview was conducted to collect data from 3 experts.

Inclusion criteria for key informants were

- 2) Engaged in vocal music teaching for more than 20 years.
- 3) A lot of Stage performance experience more than 10 years.
- 4) Graduate majoring in vocal music

Descriptive analysis is used for the information of key informants and teaching's observation.

Conceptual Framework

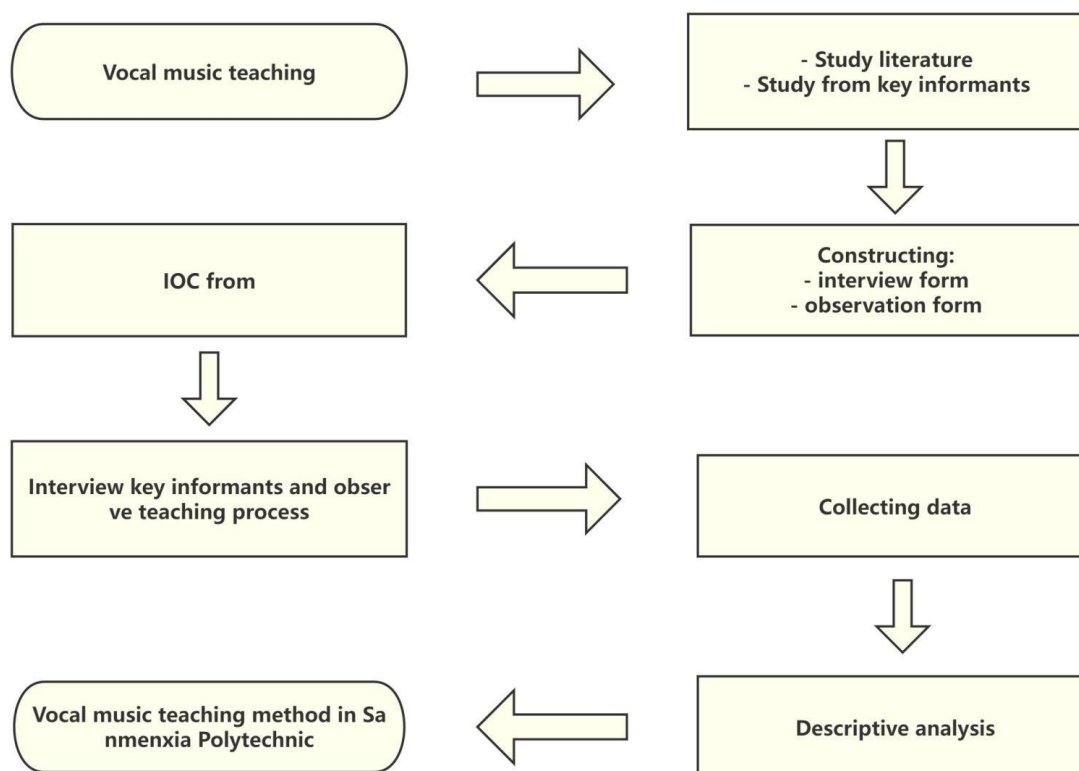


Figure 1 Conceptual Framework

Research Findings

Through the interview, the researcher discovered that vocal music instruction should emphasize a harmonious integration of theoretical knowledge and practical skills. By imparting accurate vocal techniques and facilitating ample practice opportunities, students can enhance their singing abilities while comprehending the principles underlying vocalization. Teachers should encourage students to participate in performances and competitions which will facilitate the application of acquired theoretical knowledge into practice, thereby fostering improvements in both singing proficiency and performance aptitude. Moreover, teachers should prioritize nurturing students' musical expressiveness to aid them in developing their own artistic persona and distinctive voice. Furthermore, integrating technology and online platforms into vocal music education can fortify learning outcomes while promoting interdisciplinary connections with fields like music therapy and movement studies. The ultimate objective of vocal music instruction is to foster the skills, performance proficiency, theoretical knowledge, and artistic appreciation of comprehensive music educators to meet society's demand for proficient music education professionals.

From the observation, the researcher can see that the three teachers pay more attention to the cultivation of students' vocal skills, stage performance ability and role interpretation ability in daily vocal music teaching. The content of textbooks is also relatively comprehensive which can meet the needs of students and then provide a hierarchical and organized learning method. Teachers use a variety of teaching methods, including vocal technique training, repertoire learning, performance practice, feedback and so on. The use of multimedia technology and audio-visual teaching methods enhances students' sense of learning experience. The quality requirements for students include vocal skills, musical literacy, learning attitude, learning motivation, continuous learning enthusiasm and team spirit. Through the guidance and requirements of teachers, students can develop their professional skills and literacy according to higher standards.

Problems founded in the study

Basic vocal music skills of students in Sanmenxia Polytechnic are relatively weak, and there are significant differences in students' learning ability. In addition, in recent years, the rising popularity of education majors and the expansion of enrollment have led to an increasing number of students with uneven overall levels, and some students even didn't have received systematic basic vocal music training before enrollment. At the same time, in recent years, the vocal music course teaching mode of music education still focuses on the learning of vocal music singing skills, but ignores its "educational" and the actual teaching content used in the future employment of students in primary and secondary schools, kindergartens or music education and training institutions. Therefore, in this study, the author found a series of problems to be solved by interviewing and observing classroom teaching and other activities.

Problems in Setting of class

1) Single course content: The school overemphasizes the teaching of professional courses and does not pay enough attention to music theory courses. Therefore, the imbalance of curriculum ratio leads to students' lack of knowledge in music history, solfeggio, harmony form, aesthetics and so on, which affects their understanding of vocal music works.

2) Lack of personalized teaching: The vocal music teaching of the three teachers may pay too much attention to the traditional teaching methods and standards, while ignoring the individual differences and development needs of students. As a result, the students' performances have no personal characteristics. Each student has a unique voice and learning style, so teaching methods and materials need to be personalized according to their characteristics and needs.

Problems in Teaching method:

1) Lack of diversified teaching methods: In the process of this research, the author found that although the teachers of music education major in Sanmenxia Polytechnic adopted the teaching methods based on advanced concepts to a certain extent, they still relied too much on the traditional teaching methods. However, the traditional teaching methods are too old and have not kept pace with the time. at the same time, teachers still teach all students in the same way, and do not take into account the individual differences of students. This is easy for students to keep up with the learning progress, feel boring and boring, resulting in the mood of

weariness.

2) Paying too much attention to vocal skill training: The author also found that teachers pay too much attention to skill training, which may lead to the damage of over-trained vocal cords, and ignore the cultivation of musical emotions and artistry to make their singing become mechanical and emotionless

3) Lack of practical opportunities: Due to the limited resources of the school, there is not enough time and space for practice and rehearsal, it is difficult for students to have an in-depth understanding of various vocal techniques and methods, and cannot correct mistakes in time; In the absence of real performance experience, students may be faced with a lack of confidence in their future music education positions.

4) Lack of multidisciplinary integration: vocal music classes involve a variety of disciplines, such as acoustics, musicology, anatomy, psychology, pedagogy, etc. Because vocal singing involves the production and transmission of sound, breathing control, resonance, etc., while music performance involves the understanding of works and the expression of emotions, and the teaching of vocal music also involves the fields of pedagogy and psychology. Although a variety of disciplines and fields are involved, these disciplines are not fully integrated in actual teaching. Of course, this is also a challenge that all music education majors in China are currently facing.

Problems in Textbooks

1) Use of outdated teaching materials: With the continuous development of vocal music technology, the methods and contents of some teaching materials of Sanmenxia Vocational and Technical College have become outdated, lacking of up-to-date content, and unable to keep up with the needs and development of students.

2) The content of the textbooks is not comprehensive enough: some textbooks only pay attention to the training of skills, but ignore the knowledge of music performance and music theory; There are also some problems that the repertoire in the textbook is insufficient and incomplete, which cannot meet the needs of students for learning diversified works.

3) Lack of integration of teaching materials with modern media: Some teaching materials still use traditional presentation in the age of science and technology. It is not integrated with the current excellent video, audio, short video, and excellent we-media. Although the school has made great efforts in recent years to integrate modern media into the curriculum, the results have not been very significant.

Problems of Teaching Resources

1) Insufficient teacher resources: The school lacks professional vocal music teachers. Since vocal music is an art form that requires professional skills and experience, only professional vocal music teachers with rich knowledge and practical experience can effectively guide students. However, in Sanmenxia Vocational and Technical College, the number of vocal music teachers is relatively small, unable to meet the needs of students.

2) Lack of necessary teaching equipment: With the increasing number of students in the school, the school has no piano room that can meet the needs of students' practice. The piano is old and the piano keys are out of tune, which cannot be adjusted in time.

3) Lack of teaching venues Lack and imperfection: due to the increase in the number of students majoring in music education, the demand for teaching venues such as vocal rehearsal rooms, performance stages, practical training venues, libraries, etc., also increases. However, the school space is limited, often unable to meet the needs of teaching. At the same time, the imperfect facilities and equipment also bring unstable factors to teaching.

4) Lack of practice and training platform: Music education majors in higher vocational education need to cooperate with orchestras, primary and secondary schools, kindergartens and music training enterprises, etc. However, due to the difficulty of cooperation, unstable training teachers and unequal distribution of resources, schools often fail to provide students with a sound and complete platform for practice and training.

Problems in Evaluation System:

1) Lack of diversified evaluation system: The evaluation of vocal music courses often attaches too much importance to students' singing skills, while ignoring the ability of music expression, music theory knowledge and music appreciation.

2) Unclear evaluation standards: Some vocal music course evaluation systems do not have clear standards, which makes the evaluation lack some objectivity and fairness.

3) Single assessment method: The evaluation system of vocal music course is usually only the traditional assessment method of single singing, ignoring the assessment of comprehensive practical ability such as stage performance and team performance.

4) Lack of practical application: the evaluation system of vocal music course cannot effectively guide students' career development and practical work needs, ignoring the attributes of higher vocational education and music education major. In the face of teaching practice, some primary and secondary schools and children's lack of learning vocal music works, so that it cannot be effectively applied in career development and practical work.

5) Inadequate self-evaluation of students: students lack self-evaluation in vocal music courses, and have insufficient and unclear understanding of their own learning performance and learning situation.

Discussion

Set up diversified courses and increase the proportion of music theory courses, including different courses such as music history, solfeggio, harmony form, aesthetics, etc. Through the rich curriculum, help students better understand the vocal music works and express the connotation of the works with true feelings. Personalized course teaching: According to students' individual differences and development needs, personalized teaching methods and textbooks are adopted. To understand students' voice conditions, good musical style, future career planning and other aspects, targeted design of teaching content and activities to meet students' learning needs and development goals (Hu, 2008).

Increase elective courses: Provide a variety of elective courses related to music education for different needs of students, and maximize the cultivation of students' personalized needs and professional expertise. Strengthen personalized teaching: Teachers

can provide personalized teaching methods according to the individual differences and needs of students, help them develop their own vocal music style, and increase students' learning enthusiasm and initiative. Balance skill training and artistic expression: In addition to cultivating students' vocal skills, the course should also focus on cultivating their musical expression ability, helping them better understand the background and connotation of music works, and infecting the audience with their own voice (Li, 2017).

Teaching of "integrated" courses: Such integrated teaching can include music theory, music history, performance, dance, drama and other music fields, as well as compulsory pedagogy and psychology for music education majors, as well as acoustics and decipher ology related to sound. In this way, students' comprehensive ability is improved, their artistic expression ability is enriched, and their innovative exploration steps are also enriched. Selection of diversified teaching materials: the selection of teaching materials should pay attention to the balance and rationality of the theoretical and technical content of the teaching materials, and at the same time should have certain knowledge of music theory and music performance teaching content; Chinese and foreign classical repertoire, different types of vocal music repertoire with different themes and the repertoire suitable for primary and secondary schools and children that will be applied in students' future teaching are also indispensable. Integration of modern media and teaching materials: Choose teaching materials infused with modern media, such as listening to and listening to songs by scanning QR codes, and students can also learn by themselves without teachers. Enhance students' self-evaluation ability: Teachers can encourage students to look at problems from multiple perspectives and develop their critical thinking skills. When students conduct self-evaluation and self-reflection, they are able to take a more objective look at their learning and performance. Stimulate students' interest in learning and make students more willing to actively participate in learning and reflection. Students will be more interested in learning, autonomous and motivated.

Recommendation

1. Practical Recommendations

Even the research had studied the way to improve the teaching effects from teachers' point of view and proposed effective methods for the further teaching in San Menxia Polytechnic. but basic vocal music skills of students in Sanmenxia Polytechnic are relatively weak, and there are significant differences in students' learning ability. so, teachers in this study should improve their attention to focus more on students' interests, learning ability, personalized performance on stage and so on. In addition, in recent years, the rising popularity of education majors and the expansion of enrollment have led to an increasing number of students with uneven overall levels, and some students even did not have received systematic basic vocal music training before enrollment. So in the process of the study, the researcher should take students' diversified learning ability into consideration.

2. Recommendation for future research

For the further research, the researcher suggests the teacher should set up diversified courses and increase the proportion of music theory courses, including different courses such as music history, solfeggio, harmony form, aesthetics, etc. Through the rich curriculum, help students better understand the vocal music works and express the connotation of the works with true feelings. We should also balance skill training and artistic expression: In addition to cultivating students' vocal skills, the course should also focus on cultivating their musical expression ability, helping them better understand the background and connotation of music works, and infecting the audience with their own voice. The teacher should provide students with good practice and performance venues and platforms. Let them in the stage, classroom to learn their vocal skills and vocal teaching ability to show, improve their performance ability, teaching ability and self-confidence. Update and improvement of teaching materials: Regularly update and iterate teaching materials, introduce the latest vocal music education concepts and methods, and ensure that the content of teaching materials keeps pace with The Times scientifically. Besides, the selection of teaching materials should pay attention to the balance and rationality of the theoretical and technical content of the teaching materials, and at the same time should have certain knowledge of music theory and music performance teaching content; Chinese and foreign classical repertoire, different types of vocal music repertoire with different themes and the repertoire suitable for primary and secondary schools and children that will be applied in students' future teaching are also indispensable. Integration of modern media and teaching materials: Choose teaching materials infused with modern media, such as listening to and listening to songs by scanning QR codes, and students can also learn by themselves without teachers. For example, VR equipment supporting teaching materials can be used for immersive stage performances or classroom teaching. These means and methods enrich the teaching content and students' sense of learning experience. Improve practice and training platforms: Strengthen cooperation with orchestras, primary and secondary schools, kindergartens and music training institutions, and establish and improve the construction of student practice platforms. Using multimedia, virtual VR and other technologies to provide more teaching opportunities and practical experience. As much as possible to provide students with performance stage and teaching practice platform. Last but not least, teachers can encourage students to look at problems from multiple perspectives and develop their critical thinking skills.

When students conduct self-evaluation and self-reflection, they are able to take a more objective look at their learning and performance. Stimulate students' interest in learning and make students more willing to actively participate in learning and reflection. Students will be more interested in learning, autonomous and motivated.

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
