## HASSS's Annual Report 2022

## Editor-in-Chief: Prof. Dr. Korakoch Attaviriyanupap

HASSS (former title: Silpakorn University Journal of Social Sciences, Humanities, and Arts) is an open access, double-blinded peer-reviewed journal published by Silpakorn University, Thailand. The main objective is to provide a forum for researchers in the field of humanities, arts and social sciences to publish their articles. Our mission is to promote awareness of and compatibility with the dynamics of various study areas and to disseminate research work related to art and culture, human beings and society. Since our journal was accepted to be indexed in the Scopus database in 2019, we aim to keep our journal up to international standard via different channels, especially regarding contributions of international authors and reviewers.

Under the present condition, the number of submissions to our journal has tremendously increased as shown in Table 1. In 2022, 893 articles were submitted to *HASSS* which means an increase of 34.48% compared to 2021 which had already shown a double increase. Due to the continually increasing number of submitted manuscripts, the acceptance rate has continuously been decreasing as shown in Table 2. The exact acceptance rate still cannot be calculated since some of them are still in process, especially those with the status "Accept with major revisions" which are in the revision process and have to be peer-reviewed again before the final decision is made.

Accepted Submissions in 2020-2022 came from 13 countries as shown in Table 3. Thailand represented the biggest part of total submissions as well as acceptance. The number of submissions from different countries has also increased and the involving countries are expanding positively. Regarding the articles, top 10 articles viewed and downloaded from our official website are listed in Table 4. This also shows the diversity of articles published by *HASSS* both in terms of fields of study as well as origin countries of our authors.





TABLE 1. Annual number of manuscripts accepted and rejected by HASSS

In 2022, the journal published more articles in each issue to increase the overall number of publications resulting in the publication of 64 articles in total. We welcome international or multi-national, multi-institute and multi-disciplinary manuscripts approaching the following issues: History and Philosophy; Archeology and Anthropology; Language, Linguistics and Literature; Architecture; Education; Communication and Media; Management; Political Science; Social Sciences; and Thai Studies.

Thanks to the editorial manage system (EM) we have used since January 2021 under the sponsorship of the Thai Journal Citation Index Centre (TCI), we were able to get contributions of reviewers from 18 countries including Chile, China, Czech Republic, Germany, Indonesia, Iran, Japan, Malaysia, Poland, Portugal, Singapore, Serbia, South Africa, Spain, Thailand, Turkey, Ukraine, and the United States of America. This can be considered to be another international aspect added to our journal and an indicator of the quality of our reviewing process. The distribution of countries of reviewers in 2022 is shown in Figure 1.

It is obvious that we were able to expand our academic contributions worldwide, in case we add all the countries marked in Figure 1 with those in Figure 2, i. e. countries of submissions, to the countries of contributions we had had in the past two years. In 2022, authors who submitted manuscripts to *HASSS* came from the following 54 countries: Thailand, India, Indonesia, Philippines, Malaysia, Nigeria, Pakistan, Ethiopia, Vietnam, Jordan, Bangladesh, Iran, South Africa, Saudi Arabia, Iraq, China, Ghana, South Korea, Kazakhstan, Morocco, Ukraine, Nepal, Russia, Singapore, Egypt, Poland, Australia, Albania, Afghanistan, Turkey, Hungary, United Kingdom, United Arab Emirates, Oman, Yemen, Hong Kong, United States of America, Palestine, Sri Lanka, Azerbaijan, Czech Republic, Latvia, Syria, Kenya, Taiwan, Kuwait, Lithuania, Myanmar, Lebanon, Cameroon, Germany, New Zealand, Burundi, and Tunisia.
